Guidelines for Student Rotations PIC USA Health Assurance

Guidelines:

- Third and fourth year veterinary students with an interest in swine medicine are eligible to apply.
- PIC requires a letter of recommendation from a professor.
- All students must submit a letter of intent and a resume. The letter of intent should include the specified dates on which you wish to do your rotation. We have a policy of accepting one student at a time to maximize the learning experience.
- We recommend the minimum of a 2-week rotation.
- PIC will pay for lodging and meals and will assist you in locating reasonably priced accommodations.
- Accommodations do not allow pets.
- PIC will cover flight costs and will assist in scheduling air travel if necessary.
- The cost of ground transportation will also be covered by PIC. If a rental car is utilized, expenses will be reimbursed to you. If you choose to drive your own vehicle, PIC will reimburse mileage for work-related travel, i.e. trips to farms.

Please submit resumes, letters of recommendation and letters of intent by e-mail, fax or hard copy at least 6 weeks in advance of the rotation date you request.
