## Guidelines for Student Interns PIC USA Health Assurance

We are pleased to know that you have expressed interest in doing a student internship with us at PIC. During an internship you will have the opportunity to work our staff veterinarians and consulting practitioners on research and production projects sponsored by our Health Assurance Department. Interns are expected to gain a broad perspective of the industry.

### Guidelines:

- First and second year veterinary students with an interest in swine medicine are eligible to apply.
- All students must submit a letter of intent and a resume. The letter of intent should include the specified dates on which you wish to do your internship. We have a policy of accepting one intern at a time to maximize the learning experience for everyone involved.
- PIC also requires a letter of recommendation from a professor.
- The internship is for a 12 week period.
- There will be monetary compensation for this 3 month term.
- PIC will cover half the cost for your lodging and will assist you in locating reasonably priced accommodations.
- Accommodations do not allow pets.
- You will be responsible for providing your own transportation. If you use your personal vehicle, PIC will reimburse mileage for work experiences relating to your internship, i.e. travel to another PIC assignment from your usual place of work, but not from your home to your usual place of work. If you rent a vehicle, PIC will reimburse you for the cost of that rental.

Resumes, letters of intent and letters of recommendation should be submitted by April 1<sup>st</sup> each year either by e-mail, fax, or hard copy
